Continuing the Work

As the news of the Coronavirus spread all over the country, uncertainty became a real emotion as schools closed, businesses closed and many Americans lost their jobs. As the world became fearful and unsure of what was to come, abortion clinics saw an increase in appointments as some states banned abortion. An abortion clinic director in Wichita, Kansas and Oklahoma City named Julie Burkhart said, "the calls have been frantic! We've seen more women coming sooner than they would have because they are scared they will not be able to access the services later (USA Today April 14th 2020)." Because Texas banned abortion in their state, there was an influx of women from Texas contributing to the upsurge of abortions at Burkhart's Clinic in Wichita. She said it performed 252 abortions in March 2020, up from 90 in March 2019.

As the largest abortion center in Charlotte NC remained open during COVID-19, we saw an increase in appointments for abortions right here in our backyard. Some days the appointments nearly doubled because women and families felt that they had no other choice.

Here at HELP, as the Executive Director, I knew that we could not shut our doors and deny families the resources they needed, such as pregnancy tests and the opportunity to see their unborn baby through ultrasound. The mobile unit remained parked outside of the abortion clinic 6 days a week. Our message needed to be heard now more than ever; there are alternatives to abortion. Most importantly people needed to hear that there is Hope and that their lives as well as their babies lives mattered!

In the midst of the pandemic, we were able to:

- Administer 91 ultrasounds in house and over 30 ultrasounds on our mobile unit
- Provide 97 clothing appointments for maternity clothing, diapers, and baby supplies
- Provide 9 prenatal care appointments at our medical clinic
- Provide 20 counseling appointments with men/couples
- Present the Gospel to 120 people

Our Volunteers were "Essential" to our doors staying open. We would like to give a special thanks to Shining Light Baptist Church for their large donation of nonperishable food items for our clients in need.
